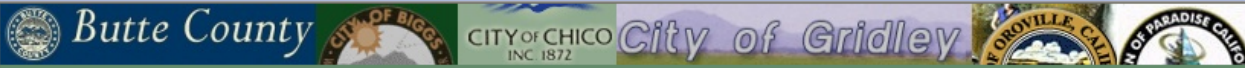

- Generalized policies (apply to all cities/town) to be drafted on behalf of the County for inclusion in City's and Town's General Plans as they become ready for update
