## Butte County General Plan 2030 Meeting Series #4 - Public Workshop Alternatives Evaluation & Development of a Preferred Alternative

### How does this workshop work?

*This workshop has two main goals: A) to present the findings of the Alternatives Evaluation to you, and B) to get your input on what the future of each study area should be. In order to accomplish these goals within the time we have available, this workshop is organized into two sets of stations: Issue Stations and Study Area Stations. It also includes a presentation and a Town Hall discussion. This sheet explains how to move through the workshop effectively.*

1. Visit the Land Use Alternatives station if you need an overview of the three land use alternatives and the locations of all the study areas.
2. Visit the Issue Stations to learn about possible constraints and issues in each study area.
3. Go to the Study Area Station(s) to review the land use alternatives for that study area, review the summary of Alternatives Evaluation Report findings, and provide input on which alternative you believe is the most appropriate for each study area. This “preferred alternative” may be one of the alternatives, a combination of the alternatives, or a new idea you create. You may visit and comment on as many study areas as you wish, but we encourage your input on those areas of the county with which you are most familiar .
4. Write your comments on the blank paper available at each study area. Please be as specific as possible so that we can accurately understand your thoughts and concerns. Please limit your comments to appropriate land use designations for that study area, rather than overarching, countywide policies.
5. Listen to the workshop overview and explanation of the alternatives evaluation process, starting at 6:00 PM, and ask staff questions about the process during the Q &A immediately following.
6. Share your comments and ideas and hear from your neighbors during the Town Hall discussion, starting at 7:00 PM.
7. Continue to visit the Issue Stations and Study Area Stations during the second open house period, from 7:30 to 8:30 PM.
8. Listen to the workshop summary, beginning around 8:30 PM, to learn about overall trends and themes among the input received by the end of the workshop.
