Attached please find the voting outcomes from the Citizens Advisory Committee's meetings of April 10, 17, 24 and May 1, 2008 on the Preferred Land Use Alternative. The May 1, 2008 Citizens Advisory Committee meeting ran long and was continued to May 8, 2008.

There were 4 Study Areas (Study Area 14: Nance Canyon/Highway 99; Study Area 10: Skyway/Neal Road; Study Area 17: Durham; Study Area 18: Durham Dayton/Highway 99) that were re-opened for comment by the Citizens Advisory Committee but were not acted upon by the Citizens Advisory Committee. The voting results on these 4 remaining Study Areas will be provided to you on May 9.

Please note that this is summary level information. A more detailed overview of the Citizens Advisory Committee's actions on the Preferred Land Use Alternative will be provided to you prior to the Planning Commission's second Study Session scheduled for May 30, 2008.
