■ BCAG Growth Projections:

- Plan for 10,000 new dwelling units in the unincorporated area by 2030
- To provide a Jobs/Housing Balance of 1:1, we need to also plan for 10,000 new jobs

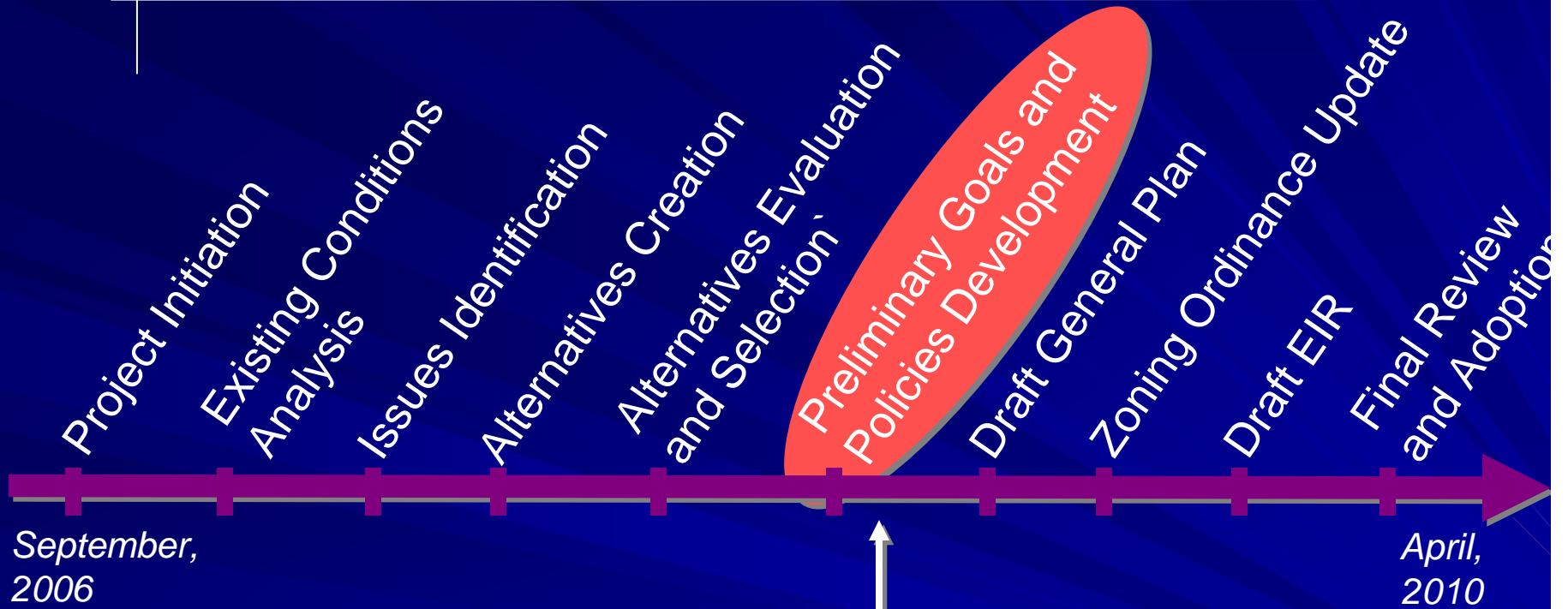

Land Use Alternatives Evaluation Report

This extensive evaluation examined the Land Use Alternatives with respect to:

- Transportation and Circulation
- Fiscal Impacts
- Agricultural Impacts
- Water Supply/Groundwater Recharge
- Wastewater Infrastructure
- Biological Resources (including the Butte Regional Conservation Plan – HCP/NCCP and Deer Range Maps)
- Cultural Resources
- Public Services (including Schools)
- Safety/Hazards

OPR Guidelines: The Intent of SB 18

“The intent of SB 18 is to provide California Native American tribes an opportunity to participate in local land use decisions at an early planning stage, for the purpose of protecting, or mitigating impacts to, cultural places. The purpose of involving tribes at these early planning stages is to allow consideration of cultural places in the context of broad local land-use policy, before individual site-specific, project-level land use decisions are made by a local government.”
